AIANTA MEMBERSHIP

MEMBERSHIP CLASS	ANNUAL DUES
TRIBAL – Federally recognized tribal governments may enact a resolution of support, authorizing membership. Tribal membership will be eligible to vote . . . 1 votes per tribe	\$500
Native American Organization – Native American owned organizations that are interested in furthering AIANTA’s objectives are eligible to become a contributing member. This member class will be eligible for 1 vote per organization.	\$300
Tribal Individual – Any American Indian Person who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized tribe may join and participate in all AIANTA activities. 1 vote and eligibility to hold office	\$100
Affiliate Organization – Non-Indian organizations who are interested in furthering AIANTA’s objectives are eligible for membership. This membership class is not eligible voting privileges.	\$600
Affiliate Individual – Any non-Indian person is eligible for membership. This membership class is eligible for 1 vote however, is not eligible to be to be elected to the Board of Directors	\$150
Student – Any person enrolled in a post-secondary education institution is eligible for membership and may participate in all activities. Student members are not eligible for voting or elected positions.	\$50
Senior – Any person who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized tribe and who is age 55+ may join and participate in all AIANTA activities. 1 vote and eligibility to hold office.	\$50
