



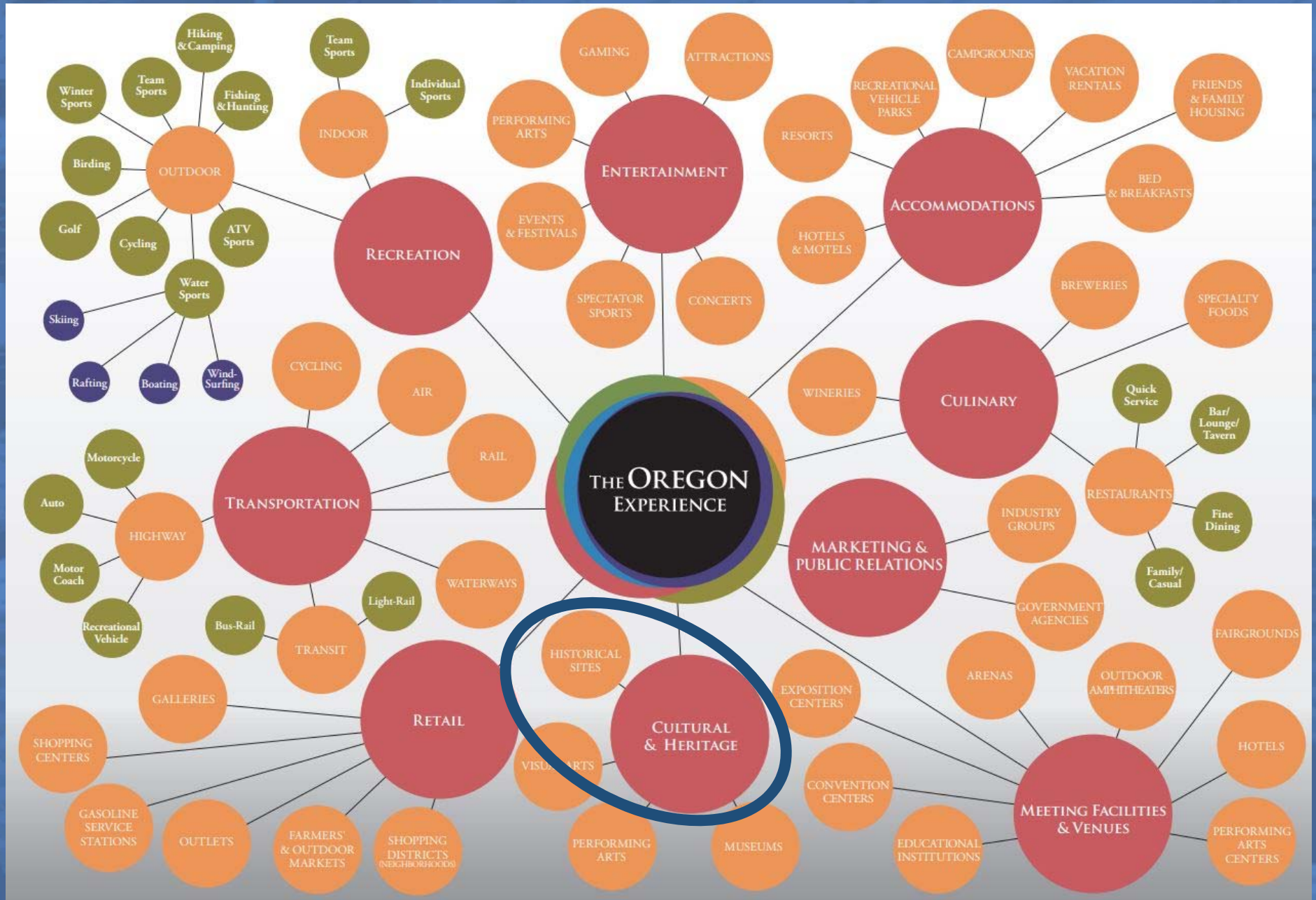

Tribal Grant Programs

- Historic Preservation Fund – oil lease revenue
- Annual grants to THPOs and competitive project grants
- May 2018 - **\$11.4M** to **175** tribal historic preservation offices
- August 2018 - **\$987K** for **23** competitive tribal heritage grants

- **\$1M since 2014**

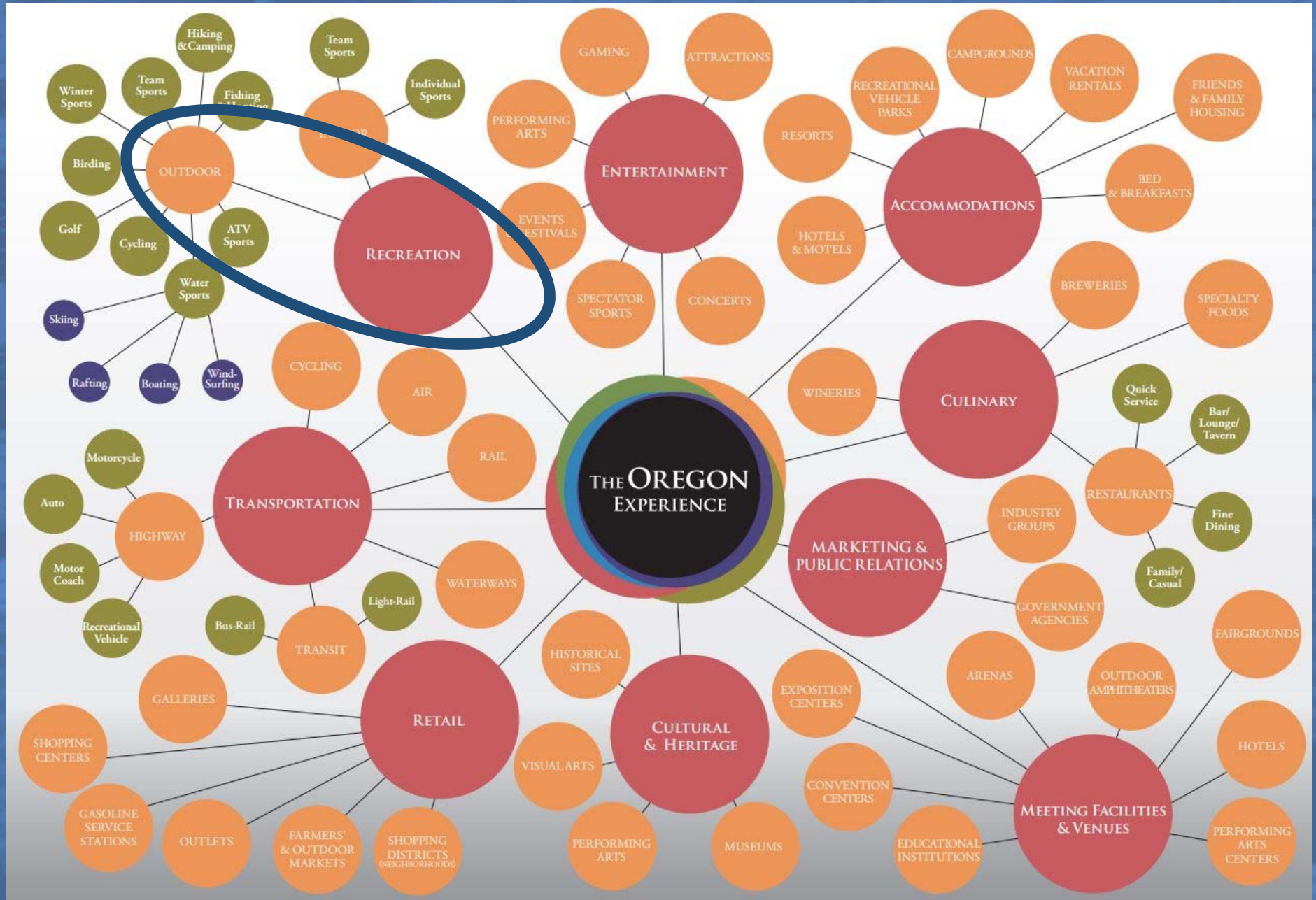

Rivers, Trails, & Conservation Assistance

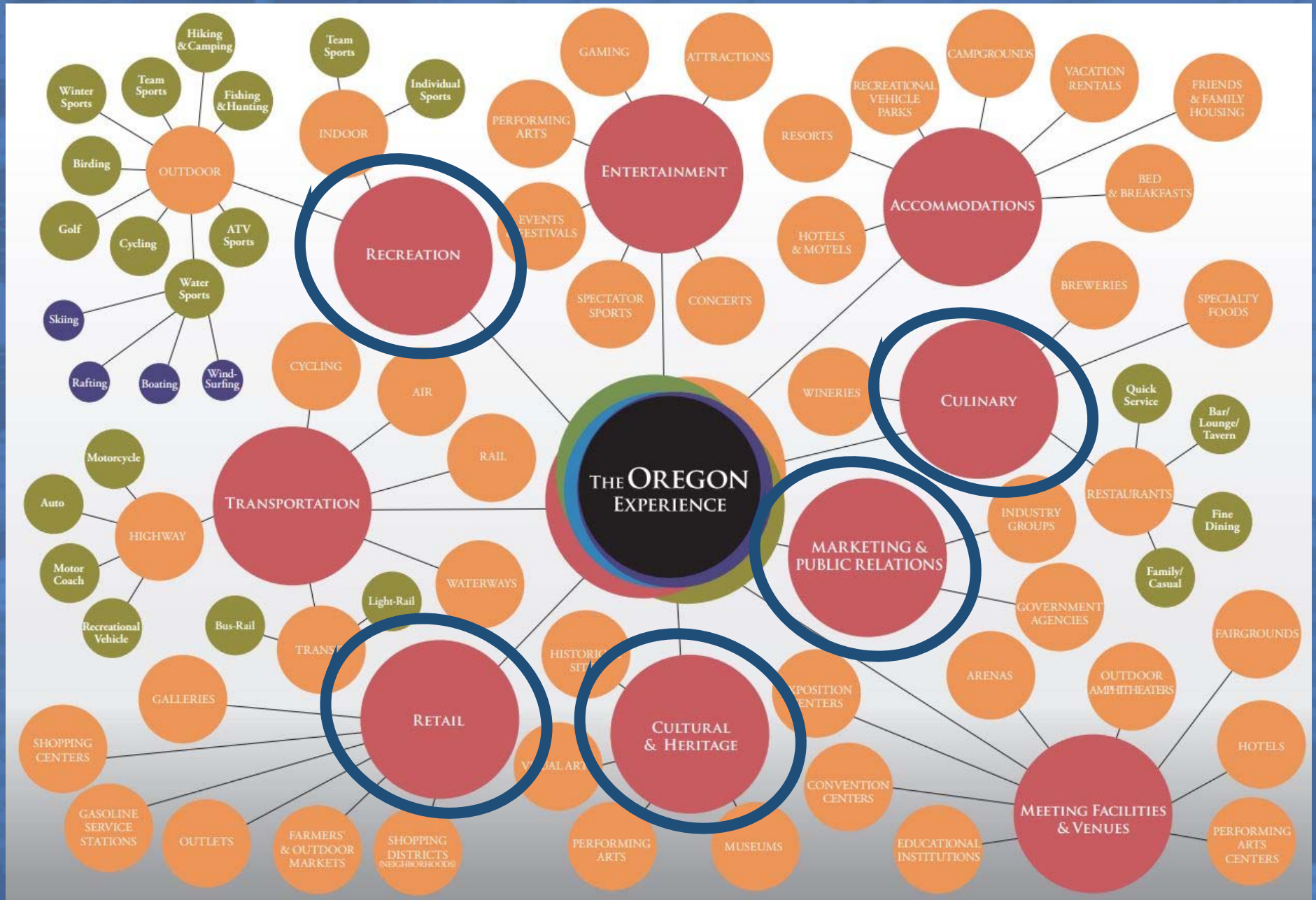
- Technical assistance to community-led conservation and outdoor recreation projects
