

### Who is EDA?

#### Mission:

To lead the Federal economic development agenda by promoting innovation and competitiveness, preparing American regions for growth and success in the worldwide economy.

#### Leading the Federal Economic Development Agenda:

 EDA provides grant-based investments to units of state and local government, universities, public or private nonprofits, District Organizations, Institutions of higher education, Indian Tribes, in communities and regions suffering from severe economic distress.



## Who is EDA?

EDA targets its investments to create (or retain) long-term, sustainable jobs and to attract private capital investment.

EDA investments are focused on locally-developed, regionally-based economic development initiatives that directly contribute to economic growth...






# Short Term Planning and Local Technical Assistance

- (Tribal) Partnership Planning Program
  - Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)
- Funding for strategies, studies, market analyses, etc.
- Funding to help make optimal economic development decisions (especially as it relates to tourism)










## **Short Term Planning and Local Technical Assistance**



EDDs funded through Partnership Planning Program annually to:

- Maintain the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)
- Provide technical assistance to counties/communities in region

**52 Tribes** funded through the Partnership Planning Program annually to:

- Maintain the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)
- (Some) Run the Office of Economic or Business Development
- Provide technical assistance and find (funding)
   opportunities for the Tribe
- Other initiatives, as needed
