TERMS & CONDITIONS

Sponsors, Exhibitors and Artisans (hereinafter known as "Exhibitor") agree to the following terms:

- 1. **Payment Deadline**: Payment must be paid in full by August 16, 2019, to receive benefits. Unpaid pledges will result in loss of benefits, including priority choice in exhibit space and listing in printed materials.
- 2. **Cancellation Policy**: Cancellation requests must be submitted by August 1, 2019, to receive refund, less a \$50 administrative processing fee.
- 3. **Cancellation of Show**: In the event of conference cancellation due to fire, strikes, government regulations, Acts of God or other causes beyond the control of the sponsoring organization, AIANTA or its agents shall not be held liable for failure to hold the conference.
- 4. **Tax Deduction:** AIANTA is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. Your donation/contribution may qualify as a tax deduction. Contact your tax advisor for more information. TIN: 45-0541654
- 5. **Artisan Booths**: AITC offers American Indian artisans and Native-owned businesses the opportunity to sell handmade/handcrafted works. AIANTA adheres to the Indian Arts and Crafts Act to define who is an Indian artist. Please be prepared to share your tribal documentation. Please, no manufactured artwork.
- 6. **Table Assignments**: Space will be assigned by AIANTA when payment is received. AIANTA reserves the right to reassign space should the need arise. Table assignments are not transferrable.
- 7. **Shipping/Storage**: Shipping and storage logistics will be sent to confirmed exhibitors. Exhibitors are responsible for shipping costs and making arrangements.
- 8. **Security/Liability:** The exhibit area is not secure. The exhibitor assumes responsibility for losses, damages and claims to equipment and other property brought upon the premises of the host facility. Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the host facility and its sponsors/organizers or any other authorized representative agent or employee of the foregoing for any and all losses, damages and claims.
- 9. **Damage**: Exhibitors will not fasten any fixtures to the floors, walls, columns or ceilings of the exhibit area. Exhibitors will be liable for any damages caused by such fastening and for any damage to equipment furnished by service suppliers designated by them.
- 10. **Permits/Licenses**: Each exhibitor is responsible for obtaining all necessary licenses and permits to use music, photographs or other copyrighted material. The exhibitor shall remain liable for and shall indemnify AIANTA, their agents and employees, harmless from all loss, cost claims, causes of actions, suits, damages, liability, expenses and costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising from or out of any violations or infringements (or claimed violation or infringement) by exhibitor, exhibitor's agent or employees of any patent, copyright or trade secret rights or privilege.
- 11. **Tables:** Vendors cannot bring in outside tables. Additional tables can be bought for \$50. Secondary tables must be fully contained in the primary exhibit space, and should not be considered access to a secondary space. No canopies or tents are allowed. All packing materials must be out of sight.
- 12. **Name Badges**: One Exhibitor registration badge is provided for full conference access and meals (does not include. artist registration). Exhibit Only Badges do not include meals or access to sessions. Meal tickets may be purchased at registration for an additional fee.
- 13. **Sharing/Subletting**: Artists cannot share a booth at any time. However, they may rotate their time example Artist 1 may display on Tuesday, while Artist 2 may display on Wednesday.
- 14. Sales Taxes: Vendors are responsible for paying sales tax on merchandise sold.
- 15. **Code of Ethics**: Exhibitor and its agents agree to adhere to AIANTA's Code of Ethics (www.aianta.org/code-of-ethics-pledge). Exhibitor and authorized representative(s) must provide a signed copy of the Code of Ethics to AIANTA along with this form.
